Driving Piling near 130 Avenue/Buffalo Run Boulevard

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors will be driving piling near the intersection of 37 Street S.W. and 130 Avenue / Buffalo Run Boulevard. The piling is required to build a new bridge that will span the northbound and southbound lanes of the Southwest Calgary Ring Road. Once complete, the bridge will provide access from the ring road to the Tsuut'ina Nation and the community of Woodbine.

Site impacts and mitigation measures will include:

- A piling rig and other bridge construction equipment working in and around the area
- An increase in noise during working hours
- Equipment entering and exiting roadways
- Site lighting will be oriented away from residences
- Dust from construction activities will be monitored and mitigation measures applied
- Access at the intersection will be maintained throughout the construction period
