### **24-Hour Operations near Sarcee Trail Interchange**

**Activity and Location:** KGL Constructors will be carrying out temporary, 24-hour operations to install a stormwater line near the Sarcee Trail Interchange. In an effort to limit noise impacts, night shift activities will be limited to work inside the excavation to lay and backfill pipe. Excavation and hauling activities will occur during the project hours of 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. The activity is expected to last until mid-December.

To minimize the impact of operations on wildlife and neighbouring residential areas, KGL will implement the following measures:

- Low noise light plants will be placed in the excavation to limit light and noise
- A berm will be built along the excavation area to limit noise
- Operations will be designed to avoid having vehicles back up
- Activity has been planned to avoid key wildlife periods
- Wildlife passage will be provided and monitored
- Only line installation and backfilling activities will be done during night shifts
- Dust will be monitored and mitigation measures applied

Work on the stormwater line follows the completion of larger-scale, 24-hour earthworks operations along the project corridor to build stormwater ponds in the Elbow River Valley. Both the stormwater ponds and line are required to contain runoff in the spring of 2019. The 24-hour earthworks are required to keep the earth from freezing at night and affecting the quality of the work.

**Scheduled Implementation Date:** Wednesday, November 28, 2018 (first night shift)

**Scheduled Completion Date:** Mid-December (last night shift)

**Hours of Work:** 24 hours a day until the completion date
