### **24-Hour Operations – Sarcee Trail to Anderson Road**

**Activity and Location:** KGL Constructors will be carrying out temporary, 24-hour earthworks operations from the area of the future Sarcee Trail Interchange to the future Anderson Road Interchange. This will involve equipment and haul trucks excavating material and moving it to build two new stormwater ponds in the Elbow River Valley. The activity is expected to last until mid-December.

To minimize the impact of this work on wildlife and neighbouring residential areas, KGL will implement the following measures:

- Site lighting will be aimed to the west and away from residential areas
- Operations will be designed to avoid having vehicles back up
- Low noise light plants will be used and will be placed in cut areas to limit noise
- Activity has been planned to avoid key wildlife periods
- Wildlife passage will be provided and monitored
- Only earthworks operations will be undertaken during night shifts
- Dust will be monitored and mitigation measures applied

**Scheduled Implementation Date:**

- Monday, November 12, 2018 (first night shift – Sarcee Trail to Elbow River)
- Wednesday, November 14, 2018 (first night shift – Anderson Road to Elbow River)

**Scheduled Completion Date:** November 27, 2018 (last night shifts)

**Hours of Work:** 24 hours a day until the completion date
