Installation of Water and Sanitary Lines near 37 Street

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors will be installing water and sanitary lines from an area near Woodbrook Road S.W. to the Tsuut'ina Nation administration office (Chief Joseph Big Plume Building). This activity will include open excavations near both communities and directional drilling under 37 Street S.W.

Other site impacts and mitigation measures will include:

- Excavations for the new water and sanitary lines
- Directional drilling for both lines under 37 Street
- Fencing will be deployed around active work sites to ensure the safety of the public
- Equipment entering and exiting roadways
- An increase in noise during working hours
- Site lighting will be oriented away from residences
- Crews will access the east receiving pit via 37 Street to reduce traffic on Woodbrook Road
- A detour will be constructed to maintain pedestrian access on the north-south pathway system
