Detour Construction near 69 Street

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors has started work for the temporary detour that will provide access at the intersection of 69 Street / Highway 8 / Discovery Ridge Boulevard S.W. during the construction period. The detour moves the traffic flow out of the footprint of the new bridge that will be built spanning the eastbound and westbound lanes of the Southwest Calgary Ring Road.

Site impacts and mitigation measures will include:

- Earthworks, road construction and paving for the new detour
- Construction equipment working in proximity to the communities of Springbank Hill and Discovery Ridge
- Equipment entering and exiting roadways
- Temporary closure of the pathway on the west side of 69 Street and Discovery Ridge Boulevard
- Detour of pedestrian traffic to the pathway on the east side of 69 Street and Discovery Ridge Boulevard
- Removal of trees from the median of Discovery Ridge Boulevard
- Dust from construction activities will be monitored and mitigation measures applied

A traffic advisory will be issued prior to realignment of traffic from the existing road onto the new detour, which is expected in late August or early September.

SWCRR Hours of Work: Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Sundays and holidays from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
