Construction Haul Route near Somerset

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors will be establishing a truck haul route in the Transportation Utility Corridor between the community of Somerset and Highway 22X (Spruce Meadows Trail). This route will provide access to move earth from the areas around James McKeivitt and 6 Street to build new westbound bridge structures at the Macleod Trail interchange and the Canadian Pacific Railway crossing.

Site impacts are expected to include:

- New traffic signals for a truck crossing on 6 Street north of Highway 22X
- Trucks and other equipment working in close proximity to existing roadways and communities
- An increase in noise during working hours
- Dust in the area will be monitored and mitigation measures applied, including regular watering

The use of the construction haul route will reduce truck traffic on Highway 22X and surrounding roads. This is to ensure the safety of the travelling public, as well as to avoid contributing to congestion and delays along Highway 22X.

Loaded haul trucks will be swept for loose material and truck beds will be covered to prevent spillage. Gravel patches will be used at the 6 Street crossing to clean tires and prevent tracking of mud onto roads.
