Driving Piling near Anderson Road

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors will be driving piling for the four new bridges that will make up the future Anderson Road system interchange. This activity will take place in the Transportation Utility Corridor between the Tsuut'ina Nation of the communities of Cedarbrae and Woodine.

Site impacts and mitigation measures will include:

- A piling rig and other bridge construction equipment working in and around the area
- An increase in noise during working hours
- Equipment entering and exiting roadways
- Dust from construction activities will be monitored and mitigation measures applied
- Fencing will be deployed around active work sites to ensure the safety of the public
- Piling will typically take place Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Pedestrians are reminded not to shortcut through the Transportation Utility Corridor for safety reasons. There will be heavy equipment working in this area to build the embankment for the new interchange and the northbound and southbound lanes of the Southwest Calgary Ring Road.

Hours of Work: Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Sundays and holidays from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
