Pathway Realignments near Cedarbrae and Woodbine

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors is starting earthworks near the communities of Cedarbrae and Woodbine for the construction of new portions of pedestrian pathway. These segments are being built to move the existing north/south pathway system outside of the footprint of the Southwest Calgary Ring Road (SWCRR). The new pathways will connect to the recently constructed pedestrian bridge spanning Anderson Road and to the existing pathway system outside of the construction area.

Access on the north/south pathway system and pedestrian bridge will remain open during the construction period for the SWCRR.

Other site impacts and mitigation measures will include:

- Equipment working in close proximity to existing pathways and communities
- An increase in noise during working hours
- Dust will be monitored and mitigation measures applied, including regular watering
- Fencing will be deployed around active work sites to ensure the safety of the public
- Site lighting will be oriented away from residences
