Pathway Realignment near Cedarbrae

Activity and Location: As part of the ongoing construction activity near the community of Cedarbrae, KGL Constructors will be realigning a portion of the north-south pedestrian pathway around earthworks to install two culverts. The culverts are part of the drainage infrastructure for the future Anderson Road interchange to capture runoff from the road and transport it to stormwater ponds.

Other site impacts and mitigation measures will include:

- Equipment working in close proximity to the existing pathway and the community
- An increase in noise during working hours
- Dust will be monitored and mitigation measures applied, including regular watering
- Fencing will be deployed around the work site to ensure the safety of the public
- Site lighting will be oriented away from residences

The previously announced construction of permanent pathways near Cedarbrae and Woodbine has been rescheduled due to utility work taking place in the pathway footprint.

Access on the north-south pathway system and Anderson Road pedestrian bridge will remain open during the construction period for the Southwest Calgary Ring Road.
