Driving Piling near Fish Creek Boulevard

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors will be driving piling south of 146 Avenue and Fish Creek Boulevard S.W. The piling is required to build a new a bridge that will span the northbound and southbound lanes of the Southwest Calgary Ring Road. Once complete, the bridge will connect Fish Creek Boulevard with the portion of 37 Street that is south of 146 Avenue.

Other site impacts and mitigation measures will include:

- A piling rig and other bridge construction equipment working in and around the area
- An increase in noise during working hours
- Equipment entering and exiting roadways
- Site lighting will be oriented away from residences
- Dust from construction activities will be monitored and mitigation measures applied
- Access to 146 Avenue will be maintained throughout the construction period
