Girder Trucks through the Tsuut'ina Nation

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors has received approval from the Tsuut'ina Nation to move several loads of bridge girders to the Elbow River valley using Nation roads.

Delivery Route:

- Trucks carrying the girders will travel on 37 Street S.W. to Bullhead Road
- The trucks will pass through the Transportation Utility Corridor before entering the Tsuut'ina Nation
- After travelling on Bullhead Road, the trucks will turn north on Weaselhead Road to reach the Elbow River valley

Delivery Timeline:

- 3:00 a.m. – trucks arrive at Bullhead Road (three girders on three trucks)
- 3:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. – the trucks are staged along the widest portion of Bullhead Road (near the Tsuut'ina Nation Health Centre)
- 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. – each of the trucks makes their way to the Elbow River valley (one truck at a time to allow the girders to be unloaded and placed)
- 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. – additional trucks with girders travel directly to the Elbow River valley

Each girder truck is accompanied by a pilot vehicle and will be escorted by the Tsuut'ina Nation Police Service to ensure the safety of the public. Tsuut'ina Nation roads will be inspected before and after the haul to check for any needed repairs.

Start date: Tuesday, April 10, 2018

Completion date: Saturday, April 14, 2018

Work hours: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (girder erection activities)
