Drilling Piling near Highway 22X and Macleod Trail

Activity and Location: Over the next month, KGL Constructors will be drilling and pouring nine piles near the interchange of Highway 22X and Macleod Trail S.E. This activity will take place sequentially at six locations in the Transportation Utility Corridor near the communities of Sundance, Chaparral and Shawnessy.

Site impacts and mitigation measures will include:

- A drilling rig and other support equipment working in and around the sites
- An increase in noise and vibration during working hours
- Equipment entering and exiting roadways
- Dust from construction activities will be monitored and mitigation measures applied
- Site lighting will be oriented away from residences
- Drilling will typically take place Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

The piles, consisting of rebar and concrete, will serve as bases for future guideposts and directional signs on the Southwest Calgary Ring Road. Additional drilled piles are planned for this area as construction progresses and additional locations become available.
