Driving Piling near Somerset and Bridlewood

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors will be driving piling for the foundation of a new bridge at the intersection of Highway 22X and James McKeivitt Road / Spruce Meadows Way (northeast of Spruce Meadows). This bridge will span the eastbound and westbound lanes of the SWCRR. The activity is in proximity to the communities of Somerset and Bridlewood.

Site impacts and mitigation measures will include:

- A piling rig and other bridge construction equipment working in and around the area
- An increase in noise during working hours
- Equipment entering and exiting roadways
- Dust from construction activities will be monitored and mitigation measures applied
- Site lighting will be oriented away from residences
- Piling will typically take place Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Scheduled Start Date: Week of October 22, 2018

Scheduled Completion Date: November 2018 (with some additional activity at a later date)

SWCRR Hours of Work: Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Sundays and holidays from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
