Single Lane Traffic on Macleod Trail at Highway 22X

Location: Macleod Trail S.E., with activity north and south of Highway 22X

Dates and Impacts:

- May 2 to 8, 2018 – 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
 - Lane closures resulting in a single lane of traffic on southbound Macleod Trail
- May 9 and 10, 2018 – 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
 - Lane closures resulting in a single lane of traffic on northbound Macleod Trail
- May 10, 2018 - 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
 - Shoulder closure on the ramp from northbound Macleod Trail to Highway 22X
 - Shoulder closure on the ramp from eastbound Highway 22X to northbound Macleod Trail

Reason: Construction of detours

Start date: Wednesday, May 2, 2018

Completion date: Saturday, May 12, 2018

Speed reduction: 50 km/hr from 70 km/hr

Other information: There will be additional lane closures outside of these hours, but a minimum of two lanes will be maintained on both northbound and southbound Macleod Trail.

For your safety, please obey all construction signs and traffic control personnel when travelling through the area.

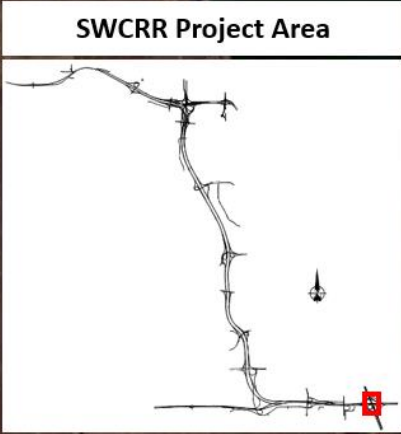


— Approximate location of activity
