Pathway Realignments near Bullhead Road

Activity and Location: The earthworks that started earlier this spring for the new Anderson Road interchange will begin expanding to the south across the closed portion of Bullhead Road and adjacent to southbound 37 Street S.W. This will result in the permanent closure of a section of the pedestrian pathway in this area and a realignment of pedestrian traffic:

- Pedestrians on the north-south pedestrian pathway will be rerouted away from the construction footprint near Bullhead Road and to the Anderson Road pedestrian bridge
- Pedestrians travelling to and from the Tsuut'ina Nation will be provided with a safe crossing area south of Bullhead Road near the alignment of the future pedestrian bridge

Pedestrians are reminded not to shortcut through the Transportation Utility Corridor for safety reasons. There will be heavy equipment working in this area to build the embankment for the new interchange and the northbound and southbound lanes of the Southwest Calgary Ring Road.

Fencing and signage will be deployed in the area to mark the closed path and to direct pedestrians to the realigned routes.

Opening of new pedestrian routes: Tuesday, July 3, 2018

Closure of existing pathway: Friday, July 6, 2018

The construction of new pathway segments in the Transportation Utility Corridor is nearing completion. This will result in continuous north-south pedestrian access along Cedarbrae and Woodbine before connecting to existing pathways of the City of Calgary.
