Gravel Processing Operations near Sherriff King Street

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors will be installing gravel processing operations in the Transportation Utility Corridor southwest of the intersection of Highway 22X and Sheriff King Street S.W. The activity will take place north of the community of Silverado behind natural or constructed barriers. The operations will process gravel that was recently discovered in the area for the construction of the Southwest Calgary Ring Road.

Site impacts will include:

- Construction equipment working in and around the area
- Haul trucks entering and exiting roadways
- A potential increase in noise during working hours

Noise mitigation measures for the operations include:

- Screening the area with berms and shipping containers
- Situating the operations over 250 metres away from the nearest community

Dust mitigation measures for the operations include:

- Equipment that uses a water system and coverings at material transfer points
- Sprinklers will be placed on stockpiles
- A truck will patrol the site to water haul roads and feedstock areas

Operations will typically take place Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., but may be extended to full project hours depending on schedule.

Scheduled Start Dates: Commissioning - week of July 9; steady-state operations - week of July 16

Scheduled Completion Date: Based on the current understanding of the gravel resource, the operations are expected to be six to 12 months (to mid-2019), but are dependent on the extent of the gravel resource

SWCRR hours of Work: Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Sundays and holidays from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
