Driving Piling near Somerset

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors will be driving piling for a new bridge structure between the community of Somerset and westbound Highway 22X (near Somerglen Common and Somerglen Close). The bridge will be part of the ramp system providing access from 6 Street S.W. to James McKeivitt Road and to the Southwest Calgary Ring Road (SWCRR).

Site impacts and mitigation measures will include:

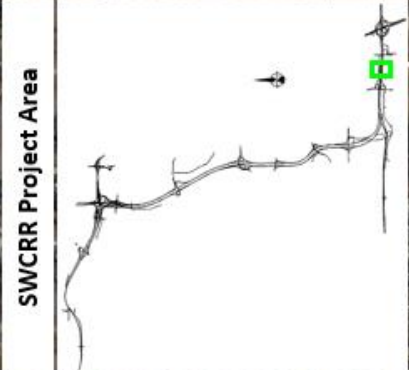
- A piling rig and other bridge construction equipment working in and around the area
- An increase in noise during working hours
- Equipment entering and exiting roadways
- Site lighting will be directed away from residences
- Dust from construction activities will be monitored and mitigation measures applied

Hours of Work: Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Sundays and holidays from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
