Earthworks and Excavation adjacent to Bridlewood

Activity and Location: As construction commences on the Southwest Calgary Ring Road (SWCRR), KGL Constructors will start working in the Transportation Utility Corridor (TUC) west of the community of Bridlewood. Upcoming activities between 162 Avenue S.W. and Highway 22X are expected to include:

- Earthworks along the length of the TUC
- An excavation adjacent to Bridlewood (a 10 to 30 metre wide buffer will be left between the community and the excavation)
- Crushing operations to process excavated gravel
- An increase in truck and equipment traffic in the area

An asphalt processing plant will be set up on site in the late summer of 2017 and will be active during summer months (weather permitting).

Noise and dust will be monitored and mitigation measures applied as needed.
