### Update on Gravel Pit & Haul Road

**Activity and Location:** Ahead of the construction season for the Southwest Calgary Ring Road (SWCRR), KGL Constructors will be developing the gravel pit in the Transportation Utility Corridor (TUC) south of Old Banff Coach Road S.W. Upcoming activities are expected to include:

- Clearing of trees, bushes and other vegetation
- Earthworks to stockpile topsoil next to the gravel pit
- Construction of a berm between the gravel pit and community of West Springs
- Earthworks to build a two-way haul road from the gravel pit to Highway 8
- Installation of traffic controls where the haul road crosses 17 Avenue and Lower Springbank Road S.W., and at the intersection with Highway 8
- Installation of air quality and noise level monitoring equipment
- Planting of trees near the berm to reduce site impacts
- Gravel extraction and crushing operations

Crushing operations are expected to start on the site in April 2017, while trucks will start running on the haul road to supply material to the SWCRR in the summer of 2017. The widening of the haul road is expected to remove the majority of truck traffic from public roads.
