Construction in Parking Lot of Admin Building

Activity and Location: In early July, KGL Constructors will start working in the parking lot of the Chief Joseph Big Plume Building. The objective of this work will be to construct new parking areas to offset those lost to the construction footprint of Tsuut'ina Trail.

Site activities and mitigation measures will include:

- Locating utilities
- Grading work
- Construction of additional parking areas
- Fencing will be deployed to ensure the safety of the public
- An increase in noise during working hours
- Equipment entering and exiting roadways
- Dust from construction activities will be monitored and mitigation measures applied

There will also be ongoing construction in the Transportation Utility Corridor east of the admin building for the Anderson Road Interchange and the future ramps to access the Tsuut'ina Nation.

Scheduled Completion Date: Late 2018 (completion of activity in parking lot)

Hours of Work: Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Sundays and holidays from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
