### Closure of Macleod Trail at Highway 22X

**Location:** Macleod Trail S.E. at the interchange with Highway 22X

**Impacts:**

- Full closure of northbound and southbound Macleod Trail
- Closure of the ramp from eastbound Highway 22X to northbound Macleod Trail
- Detour of traffic to nearby ramps and roads

**Reason:** Bridge demolition and girder erection

**Start date:** Friday, February 1, 2019, at 8:00 p.m.

**Completion date:** Monday, February 4, 2019, at 6:00 a.m.

**Work hours:** 24-hours a day until completion

**Speed limit:** 50 km/h from 70 km/h

**Other information:**

- Signs will be posted to guide drivers when the detours are active
- Traffic control personnel will be deployed at intersections to guide vehicles
- Activity will include night shifts to complete the work in a short window, which will be less impactful for motorists travelling through the area
- The closures allow KGL to install bridge girders while demolition is ongoing, which will reduce future closures that would have been required for bridge construction
- Drivers are encouraged to consider alternate routes, including Deerfoot Trail

For your safety, please obey all construction signs and traffic control personnel when travelling through the area.
