Demo Operations on Highway 22X at Railway Line

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors will be demolishing the old bridge on Highway 22X across the Canadian Pacific Railway line, so that a new structure can be built in its place (between Sheriff King Street and Macleod Trail). The scope of work will include demolition activity, removal of girders and transport of material from the area.

Site impacts and mitigation measures will include:

- Equipment working in and around the area
- An increase in noise and vibration during operations
- Equipment entering and exiting Sheriff King Street
- Dust from activities will be monitored and mitigation measures applied
- Site lighting will be oriented away from residences
- Fencing will be deployed around the active work site to ensure the safety of the public

In order to safely work around rail traffic, KGL will be scheduling activities to coincide with large time gaps between trains.
