Driving Piling at Macleod Trail and Highway 22X

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors will be driving piling for the foundation of new bridges at the interchange of Highway 22X and Macleod Trail S.E. These are the locations of bridges for eastbound traffic on the SWCRR, which recently became available when traffic on Highway 22X was realigned to the north in December.

Site impacts and mitigation measures will include:

- A piling rig and other bridge construction equipment working in and around the area
- An increase in noise during working hours
- Equipment entering and exiting roadways
- Dust from construction activities will be monitored and mitigation measures applied
- Site lighting will be oriented away from residences
- Piling will typically take place Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Scheduled Completion Date: Periodic activity to summer 2019

SWCRR Hours of Work: Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Sundays and holidays from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
