Driving Piling near Woodbine

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors will be returning to the Woodbine area to drive additional piling for the new pedestrian bridge spanning 37 Street south of Anderson Road S.W. The bridge will provide a connection between Woodbine (near Woodbrook Road and Woodbriar Place) and the area near the Tsuut'ina Nation Gas Bar. The bridge, running east/west, will span the future northbound and southbound lanes of the Southwest Calgary Ring Road.

Site impacts and mitigation measures will include:

- A piling rig and other bridge construction equipment working in and around the area
- An increase in noise and vibration during working hours
- Equipment entering and exiting roadways
- Dust from construction activities will be monitored and mitigation measures applied
- Site lighting will be oriented away from residences
- Piling will typically take place Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

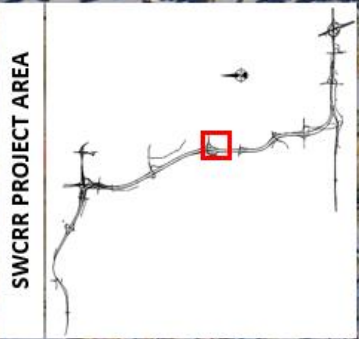
Scheduled Completion Date: Early May 2019
