Extension of SWCRR Construction Hours

Activity and Location: KGL Constructors has worked with Alberta Transportation to extend the project hours for construction of the Southwest Calgary Ring Road in the Transportation Utility Corridor. Starting in May 2019, 24-hour operations will take place on structures and roadways at key project locations including:

- Glenmore Trail and 37 Street S.W
- Sarcee Trail interchange
- Anderson Road interchange
- 37 Street S.W. crossing Fish Creek

The extended project hours are expected to last until December 2019 to help prepare for critical upcoming traffic realignments and to maintain the SWCRR completion schedule. Other locations are expected to be added to the 24-hour operations as required to meet the project schedule.

To minimize the impact of night time operations on neighbouring residential areas, KGL will implement the following additional measures:

- Low noise generators and light plants will be used (or screened from communities to limit noise)
- Equipment will use white noise back-up alarms or similar alternatives
- Dust will be monitored and mitigation measures applied
- Wherever possible, site lighting will be oriented away from residences
- Work will shut down during adverse weather conditions

Hours of Work: 24 hours a day, seven days a week, until the completion date
