Construction Activities

While construction can be disruptive, it is important that work continues on the Southwest Calgary Ring Road. When completed, the Calgary Ring Road will provide approximately 100 Kilometres of free flow traffic around the City of Calgary. This is expected to have a significant impact for Calgarians, reducing commute times within the city and will also benefit the economy of Alberta by allowing for the efficient movement of goods and people within Alberta. Below we have outlined some key activities that are taking place this week.

Macleod Trail SE to 37th Street SW

- Drainage Installations
- Minor Traffic Accommodation Changes
- Excavation and Embankment
- Bridge Construction

162nd AVE SW to Anderson RD SW

- Drainage Installations
- Excavation and Embankment for future northbound alignments
- Bridge deck pours at Anderson Interchange

Anderson RD SW to Sarcee Trail SW

- Continue Excavation and Embankment in the Valley
- Gravel Placement and Paving on completed sections
- Bridge deck Pours and Bridge Construction

Grey Eagle Casino to West Project Limits

- Drainage Installation along Highway 8
- Excavation of Embankment along Highway 8
- Completion of Bridge Works along Highway 8
- Gravel Placement and Paving

While KGL will endeavour to minimize impacts to adjacent residents where practical, the scale of this project will result in impacts to the public including dust, noise from construction activities, changes to the access for both pedestrians and vehicles, and changes to the visual landscape as construction moves forward and infrastructure is completed.
