Outlined below are some key construction activities that will be taking place this week. While construction can be disruptive, it is important that work continues on the Southwest Calgary Ring Road. We anticipate significant progress to be made over the coming months. Thank you for your continued cooperation and patience during construction.

37th Street SW South of 130th AVE SW (NEW)

- Civil Drainage Installations
- Minor Traffic Accommodation Changes
- Backfill Activities

Macleod Trail SE to 37th Street SW (ongoing)

- Drainage Installations
- Minor Traffic Accommodation Changes
- Excavation and Embankment
- Bridge Construction

162nd AVE SW to Anderson RD SW (ongoing)

- Drainage Installations
- Excavation and Embankment for future northbound alignments
- Bridge deck pours at Anderson Interchange

Anderson RD SW to Sarcee Trail SW (ongoing)

- Continuation of Excavation and Earthworks
- Gravel Placement and Paving on completed sections
- Bridge deck Pours and Bridge Construction

Grey Eagle Casino to West Project Limits (ongoing)

- Drainage Installation along Highway 8
- Excavation of Embankment along Highway 8
- Completion of Bridge Works along Highway 8
- Gravel Placement and Paving

While KGL will endeavour to minimize impacts to adjacent residents where practical, the scale of this project will result in impacts to the public including dust, noise from construction activities, changes to the access for both pedestrians and vehicles, and changes to the visual landscape as construction moves forward and infrastructure is completed.
